ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Founded in the picturesque village of Eguisheim following WWII, Domaine Mann – Vignoble des 3 Terres is now helmed by Sébastien Mann, who joined the family estate in 2006.
- Looking to gain experience from many regions, Sébastien trained in Champagne, the Rhône, Austria, and Australia before returning to his home region.
- Domaine Mann Vignoble des 3 Terres has been certified organic since 2008 and achieved its Biodyvin certification in 2015.
- Planted to 12.8 hectares of local varietals, the estate produces vins des soif from young vines as well as single vineyard wines (some of Grand Cru status).
- Sébastien is hands-on throughout the winemaking process and produces wines that represent the best of Alsace.

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

A blend of several different plots with an average vine age of 36 years. In accordance with their organic and biodynamic principles, all their vineyards have natural grass cover and have compost added in the fall.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Hand-picked. Gentle pressing and native yeast fermentation. Aging for 15-20 months (60% in barrel) on the lees.
