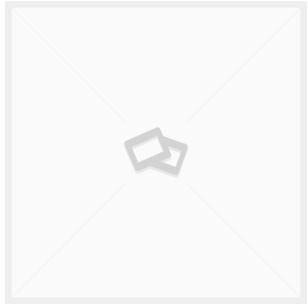


Domaine Mayard

ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Domaine Mayard is a new estate in Châteauneuf-du-Pape that also has generations of history.
- Arthur and Hugo Mayard have established their own estate following the separation of the family's vineyards.
- Long-term sustainability is the focus, with potential longevity of the vines bolstered by organic farming methods and biodiversity.
- The estate comprises about a dozen hectares in several communes in Châteauneuf-du-Pape and Côtes-du-Rhône.
- With six generations of knowledge to rely on, Arthur and Hugo are creating outstanding wines that will contribute to the next chapter of this storied family.

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

From the Sabran, Thezan, La Chapelle, Valoris, and Plet lieux-dits, Vines planted between 1905 and 1990. 25 hl/ha.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Grapes are hand harvested, sorted in the vineyard and also in the cellar. Native yeast fermentation in inox for 15 days using the R'Pulse maceration technique every day for two minutes. Aged in concrete tanks and bottled eight months after harvest.
