ABOUT THE ESTATE

- An estate with serious lineage behind its holdings, Domaine Morey-Coffinet was founded in the late 1970s by Michel and Fabienne Morey, who were succeeded by their son Thibault in 2009.
- With deep roots in the Côte de Beaune, Thibault is well-positioned to continue to take this estate to the next level.
- He has earned the respect of his peers through his thoughtful and detailed approach. In 2014, he began to pursue biodynamic viticulture, and in 2015 gained certification.
- In the cellar, care is taken during vinification and SO2 is kept to a minimum.
- This young winemaker has earned the nickname "the rising star of Chassagne-Montrachet" and leads the way for his generation of vignerons.

From a 0.96 hectare parcel in the village of Chassagne, both the Santenay and Puligny sides, planted in 1988, 2001, and 2012.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Aged in 10 months in 228 and 350 L oak barrels, 25% new. Unfiltered.
