ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Domaine du Séminaire lies tucked into the hills of Valréas, an idyllic property that offers a snapshot of a long-ago time.
- The 100 hectares are planted to olive and oak trees, lavender, and forest as well as vine, making this a hot-spot of biodiversity.
- In the foothills of the Alps, this terroir represents the northern reaches of where Grenache can successfully ripen, walking the tightrope between full ripeness and bright acids.
- Hervé and Mathilde Pouzin are the fourth generation to tend these vines, and keep viticulture and vinification traditional. Their main “modernization” has been to convert all the vineyards to organic farming.
- It's a labor of love to make these Côtes-du-Rhône and they are exceptional examples of what this striking terroir can bring.

GRAPE VARIETY

50% Grenache, 50% Syrah

FARMING

Sustainable, Organic (Ecocert), Vegan

SOIL

Predominantly safre with clay-limestone

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

From vines planted in the early 1960s (Grenache) and mid-2000s (Syrah). The vineyards are situated at the east of the commune of Valréas, on the hillsides overlooking the town.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

Grapes are destemmed and fermented with native yeast for 21 days with pumping under controlled temperatures. Aged in concrete tanks and bottled with very light filtration.
