ABOUT THE ESTATE

- Château Tour des Gendres was established in the 1980s in the Bergerac village of Ribagnac.
- Founder Luc de Conti has now passed on his property to children Margaux and Gilles, who carry on his legacy.
- All farming is organic and biodynamic and innovation is the watchword, all in service of advancing the quality of the wines.
- Recent techniques include high-density planting, growing new varieties, and incorporating new oak, micro-oxygenation, and Stockinger foudre into the winemaking process.
- This estate has made its mark in Bergerac. Margaux and Gilles are excited to continue exploring and experimenting, highlighting the excellence of their terroir.

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Malbec, 25% Merlot

FARMING

Sustainable, Organic

SOIL

Clay-calcareous with limestone

VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

These soils are water-poor, south-facing, and on a slight hill.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION

The grapes are 100% destemmed before punch down. Long maceration for 30 days with micro-oxygenation under the cap. Malolactic fermentation occurs in the vat. Aging in barrels and foudres (large oak vats) for 12 months (30% new, 70% in one-and two-year-old barrels), followed by six months in vats with lees stirring. No fining or filtration.
